Scanned copies of the relevant enclosures shall be submitted along with the requisite registration fee in the form of online payment, failing which it will be treated as rejected. Original documents shall be produced at the time of interview																								
2.	Candidates must read all the instructions before filling the application form. A prescribed format of Application is available on the University website www.mgmu.ac.in .																								
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4.	Application Form found incomplete in any respect shall be rejected without any notice.																								
5. For determining "Good Academic Record" the following criteria shall be adopted. a) A candidate holding a Ph.D. Degree should possess at least a Second Class Master's Degree or b) A candidate without Ph.D. Degree should possess High Second Class Master's Degree and Second Class in the Bachelor's Degree, or c) A candidate not possessing a Ph.D. Degree but possessing Second Class Master's Degree should have obtained First Class in the Bachelor's Degree. All qualifications and experience will be considered as on the closing date, i.e. the last date of receipt of application form.																								
7.	A Fee of ` 1500/- for teaching and Rs. 500 for Non- Teaching towards processing charges (non-refundable) should be paid online through online payment Gateway. Processing fee details are given in the online application form candidate

14.	The University reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates for interview to a reasonable limit, on the basis of qualification and experience, higher than those prescribed in this advertisement, and as per criteria decided by scrutiny committee
