General / Minimum Qualifications And Instructions:

- Good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent Degree from an accredited Foreign University.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- Candidates, who have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the *University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph. D. Degree) Regulations, 2009*, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.
- NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in Disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

Allocation of teaching workload will be as per the Maharashtra Government Policy.

- Remuneration to be paid to the Teachers on Clock Hour Basis (CHB) as per Government Resolutions and resolutions passed by Management Council of this university in this regard will be as follows.

10.	Canvassing in any form for any candidate will result in disqualification of candidature. Impersonation or submission of false/fabricated/tampered documents or making incorrect/false statements by a candidate, shall, in addition to debarring him/her permanently or for a specific period from any employment in the University, will also render him/her liable for criminal prosecution.

21.	No alteration in the prescribed format is permitted. Separate sheet should be attached where space is required.

In case of recruitment to the teaching posts in the University, in a subject of inter- disciplinary nature where Teachers are drawn from different subjects/ faculties, the recruitment qualifications required for the concerned subject/faculty for the respective post in the University shall be applicable.
23.	A relaxation of the minimum marks at the PG level from 55% to 50% for appointment as Assistant Professor may be provided to the candidates who have cleared the JRF examination conducted by UGC/CSIR only prior to 1989, when the minimum marks required to appear for JRF exam were 50%.
24.	Equivalent grade B in the 7 point scale, with letter grades O,A,B,C,D,E, and F, shall be regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed.

25.	A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have passed their Master's Degree prior to 19th September 1991.
26.	A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks, at the Master's level for SC/ST categories.
27.	As per Government Resolution No. NGC-1494/(2991)/Uni-4 dated 20-11-1996, reservation is not applicable to isolated posts.
28.	Reservation has been made applicable in the light of Government Resolution No.BCC/1097/PK/63/16-B dated 18-10-1997 issued by the B.C. Cell, General Administration Department Mantralaya, Mumbai to the Universities and affiliated colleges vide Government Resolution No.NGC-1495/3183/Uni-4 dated 8th December 1997 issued by the Higher and Technical Education Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai.
29.	If the candidates from women category are not available, the male candidate from the same category will be considered for selection as per Government Resolution No Sankirna / 1096 / pra. Kra 30 / ka-2 dated 1.8.1997 for appointment.
30.	Candidates belonging to specific reserved category from Maharashtra State only shall be considered for reserved post and they are required to submit Caste Certificate/ Caste Validity Certificate at the time of joining, in case it is not submitted along with the application form.
31.	Separate application for separate post is necessary.
32.	Relevant experience and educational qualifications shall be counted as on the last date prescribed for making Online applications, <i>i.e., 20-07-2022.</i>
33.	If the candidates from earmarked reserved category are not available, the reservation for the same post will be considered as per Government Resolution No BCC/ 1094 / CR-57/94/16-ब dated 5.12.1994 for appointment.
34.	The reservation specified for the VJ(A),NT(B),NT(C) and NT(D) categories shall be inter transferable. If suitable candidates for the posts reserved for any of the said categories are not available in the same recruitment year, the posts shall be filled in by appointing suitable candidates from any of the other categories.
35.	A Fee of ₹ 200/- (for Open category) and ₹ 100/- (for candidates belonging to reserved categories) towards processing charges (non-refundable) should be paid online through online payment Gateway. Processing fee details are given in the online application form candidate login or the candidate can remit the said amount in the Accounts Section, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad and enclose the original Receipt with the application form. The receipt of the payment must be placed / tagged at the top of the application.
36.	For pre-IAS Coaching Centre Positions :- Preference will be given to the candidates who have appeared at UPSC/MPSC mains Examination.

- [1] The applicant should apply Online on link www.bamu.ac.in. Hard Copy in **Two** sets and completed in all respects, along with necessary documents duly attested shall be submitted at the time of Interview.
- [2] The candidate applying for the post of reserved categories should submit Caste Certificate / Caste Validity Certificate issued by competent authority. The appointment of the selected candidate on respective Reserved Category shall be made only after the receipt of Caste/Caste Validity Certificate in the light of Govt. of Maharashtra G. R. No. CBC10/2010/Pr. Kr. 47/mavk-5, dated 26-03-2010.

- [3] The candidates belonging to the category VJ (A), NT (B, C, D) and OBC should submit Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued on or after 01-04-2020 by competent authority for claim under reservation.
- [4] 30% of reservation for Women Candidates shall be applicable as per the Women and Child Welfare Department, Government of Maharashtra, Resolution No. 82/2001/मसेवा -२०००/प्र.क्र. ४१५/का.२ दिनांक २५ मे २००१. The female candidates belonging to Open Category and seeking Woman reservation are compulsorily required to submit Non - Creamy Layer Certificate issued by competent authority on or after 01-04-2019 along with application form. Non - Creamy Layer Certificate will not be required for SC, ST candidates.
